

JOB DESCRIPTION

Post: Community Support Worker

Reports to: Support at Home Project Manager

Main Purpose of the Role

The postholder will participate as part of a team providing support to Veterans and their families in their own homes and within the community, to enable them to live as full, active and independent a life as possible, aligned to the individual assessed needs.

DUTIES/RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Develop and maintain relationships with service users, families, friends, stakeholders and advocates.
- 2. Deliver support within the home to meet the needs of service users during scheduled visits.
- 3. Accompany service users on outings within their community, including outings, appointments and shopping.
- 4. Assist service users with housekeeping and meal preparation as required.
- 5. Contribute to the development, recording and review of service user support plans.
- 6. Report any changes, issues, concerns to the Project Manager.
- 7. Maintain and respect the dignity of service users at all times,
- 8. Undertake all mandatory training required to fulfil the needs of the post.
- 9. Operate safe working practices, with due regard to Food Safety, Health & Safety Regulations, COSHH, control of infection, waste disposal.
- 10. Report all accidents and incidents accurately and timely.
- 11. Any other duties as required within the scope of the role.
